**PROCEDURE FOR OBTAINING A VEHICLE INSPECTION CERTIFICATE
(ROAD WORTHINESS) FOR INDIVIDUAL AND BUSINESSES/FLEET**

GUIDING LAW & REGULATIONS

In pursuant of the provisions of the Road Traffic Law Cap 127, Laws of Kebbi State Vol. 4 1977

Administration and Collection of Revenue Due to the Kebbi State Government and Local Government Council (Amendment) Law, 2023.

All individuals and organizations seeking to obtain Vehicle Inspection Certificate (VIC) from Kebbi State can apply through the following process;

Step 1: Prepare the following relevant documents;

- Vehicle purchase receipt
- Customs Clearance Certificate
- Proof of Ownership Certificate
- Evidence of Corporate Affair Registration CAC (**For fleet**)
- Tax Clearance Certificate (TCC) and Tax Identification Number [TIN] (for all forms of business).

Step 2: Pay applicable fee

Payment can be made across the following channels:

- Any Commercial Bank in the State using the TSAKEBBIPAYDIRECT account.
- Pay Inspection charges (see below) at SBIR Customer Service Centre located at the Ministry of Works & Transport, Haliru Abdu Secretariat Complex, Birnin-Kebbi. Upon payment, applicants will instantly be issued a General Motor Receipt (GMR).

Step 4: Submit relevant documents

Kindly present original copies and submit copies of documents listed in step 1 above, together with GMR in Step 3 above to the Ministry of Works & Transport, Haliru Abdu Secretariat Complex, Birnin-Kebbi

Step 5: Vehicle Inspection

Kindly drive your vehicle to Ministry of Works & Transport, Haliru Abdu Secretariat Complex, Birnin-Kebbi for inspection.

Vehicles will be inspected **within 24 hours** of payment of fees and submission of documents

Step 5: Approval and issuance of Road Worthiness Certification

Successful applicants are issued Road Worthiness Certificate RWC within 3 hours of completion of inspection.
