PROCEDURE FOR OBTAINING AN ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT ASSESSEMENT REPORT (EIA)

Guiding Laws & Regulation

In pursuant of the provisions of the *Kebbi State Environmental Protection Authority Edict No. 4, 1995* and other Matters Connected, as well as the *Administration and Collection of Revenue Due to the Kebbi State Government and Local Government Council Law, 2023*, all individuals and organizations seeking to acquire an Environmental Impact Assessment Report (EIA) in Kebbi State can apply through the following process:

STEP 1: Start your application by obtaining an application form at:

STEP 2: Prepare all relevant documents.

To process your application for an EIA Report the following documents are required:

- a. A copy of KEBGIS Certificate of Occupancy CofO).
- b. Site Analysis Report SAR prepared by consultants with a clear satellite image, sealed, stamped, and endorsed by a Town Planning Registration Council (TOPREC) registered town planner (for all developments)
- c. Building Plan/Development Permit issued by KUDA
- d. Soil Investigation Report (SRI) (for multi-storey buildings that exceed three floors)
- e. Feasibility/Visibility report prepared by consultants (for mass housing, agricultural, petrol/gas station, commercial, industrial development).
- f. Tax Clearance Certificate (TCC) and Tax Identification Number [TIN] (for all developments)..
- g. Service approvals including Fire and Police Reports (for petrol/gas stations, hotels and multi-storey developments that exceeds four floors). Visit/contact any fire service department/police station nearest to you in Kebbi State for a fire/police report.
- h. Recent utility bill or bank statement (containing same address with contact address specified on form).

STEP 3: Pay applicable fee

Please see applicable fees & charges as stipulated on Schedule VII Part M (Page 102) of the *Administration and Collection of Revenue Due to the Kebbi State Government and Local Government Council Law, 2023* -

Pay the applicable fee of **N20,000** using any of the available payment channels:

- TSA Online payment platform via Remita - <https://login.remita.net/remita/onepage/G0000308016/biller.spa>
- Any Commercial Bank in the State using the TSAKEBBIPAYDIRECT account.
- PoS using a debit/credit card at the Customer Service Desk located at KESEPA Head Office

STEP 4: Submission of documents

Submit the duly completed application form at the Customer Service Desk at KESAPA head office, relevant documents in step 2 above and evidence of payment of fees.

Applicants will be provided a unique Application Reference Number and an Acknowledgement Letter that carries the file number for the application by KESEPA within seven (7) days from the date of submission.

STEP 5: EIA approval

Submitted applications for EIA Report will be processed **within 21 working days** from the date of submission of documents

STEP 6: Collection of EIA report

Applicants will be notified via SMS and/or email when a decision on approval has been made. Applicants are to collect approved EIA report at KESEPA Head Office, Haliru Abdu Secretariat Complex, Birnin Kebbi in person **OR** may issue an authorization letter duly signed by the applicant attaching KESEPA's Acknowledgement Letter, Passport of applicant and valid identity card of the representative.
