Executive Summary

The baseline mapping exercise for Primary Healthcare (PHC) workers in Kebbi State was carried out to determine the total number of staff across government-owned facilities, identify critical human resource gaps, and propose a comprehensive recruitment and deployment plan. This exercise was conducted under the collaborative efforts of the Kebbi State Government, the Ministry of Health, and the Primary Healthcare Development Agency.

The findings revealed that Kebbi State has 752 government-owned PHC facilities distributed across its 21 Local Government Areas (LGAs), with Danko-Wasagu housing the highest number of facilities (77) and Shanga the least (12). PHC facility density—indicative of accessibility—was highest in Sakaba (2.8) and lowest in Bagudo (0.5). Furthermore, 77% of these facilities are in rural areas, underscoring a significant rural bias in the distribution.

The workforce composition includes 6,479 staff members, with a gender split of 38% female and 62% male. Danko-Wasagu hosts the largest number of staff (626), while Aliero has the fewest (115). The average staff-to-facility ratio stands at 9, with Yauri leading with an average of 17, and Suru at the lower end with just 4.

A workforce gap analysis based on the National Primary Health Care Development Agency's (NPHCDA) minimum standards reveals critical shortages. Key findings include a complete absence of Medical Officers (100% gap) and major deficits for Community Health Officers (94%) and Junior Community Health Extension Workers (90%). Addressing these gaps requires significant financial investment, with a projected annual cost of ₦1.35 billion in 2025, ₦1.12 billion in 2026, ₦898.8 million in 2027, ₦695.86 million in 2028, and ₦463.90 million in 2029, with inflationary impact factored in.

The gaps underscore suboptimal performance within the PHC system, necessitating urgent intervention. Recommendations include increasing budgetary allocations for primary healthcare to bridge the human resource gaps and centralizing PHC management under the Kebbi State Primary Healthcare Development Agency (SPHCDA) in line with the Primary Health Care Under One Roof (PHCUOR) policy.

1.0 INTRODUCTION

The efficiency of any healthcare system is intrinsically linked to the quality, distribution, and management of its workforce. Human resources for health, as defined by the World Health Organization (WHO), include all individuals who promote and preserve health, diagnose illnesses, and deliver medical care. A well-structured health workforce is closely associated with improved outcomes, such as enhanced access to primary care, increased vaccination rates, and reduced maternal and infant mortality. Furthermore, healthcare workers represent a significant portion of health budgets, highlighting their crucial role in achieving impactful and sustainable health system performance.

In Kebbi State, the necessity for a well-coordinated and adequately supported health workforce management system cannot be overstated. Strategic and equitable workforce distribution is essential for delivering quality healthcare services across both urban and rural areas. By addressing existing gaps in healthcare staffing, the State can reduce health tourism, ensuring that residents no longer need to travel to other states or countries in search of quality healthcare. This will enhance citizens' trust and satisfaction while also strengthening the State's capacity to meet national and international health standards.

Effective planning, development, and management of the health workforce are vital for enhancing its quality and skill set. Accurate and timely data on human resources for health can facilitate regulatory processes, reduce misinformation, and support strategic decision-making. To achieve these goals, Kebbi State must prioritize establishing a robust framework for workforce management to deliver equitable, efficient, and quality health services across all Local Government Areas (LGAs). Such efforts will not only benefit the primary healthcare system but also catalyze broader socio-economic development in the State.

1.1 Background

Management of human resources for health has been one of the major challenges facing the health sector, especially the primary health sector. Critical gaps in the workforce and maldistribution of the workforce often constitute a cog in the wheel of effective and efficient service delivery. The fragmented nature of management and its political interference do form part of the bottlenecks towards addressing identified challenges. In Kebbi State, the case is not different as the primary health care system is plagued with the aforementioned challenges.

To address the human resources challenges in the primary health care system, the Nigeria Human Capital Opportunities for Prosperity and equity-governance (HOPE-GOV) required the Kebbi State government to conduct a baseline mapping exercise for primary health care workers to have credible data upon which further primary health workers' recruitment and deployment will be based, for effective human resource management.

1.2 Objectives of the Baseline Mapping Exercise

The objectives of the baseline mapping exercise were to:

- i. Ascertain the total number of staff in primary healthcare facilities in the State.
- ii. Identify human resources gaps in primary health care facilities in the State.
- iii. Develop and propose a recruitment and deployment strategy and plan for primary health care human resources to the State.

1.3 Scope of the Baseline Mapping Exercise

This mapping only considered the workforce in government-owned primary health care facilities in the State.

1.4 Methodology

1.4.1 Approach

The baseline survey adopted a mixed survey method leveraging desk research and existing database review for secondary data, and the use of a survey form to triangulate and update the data collected from secondary sources. The exercise uses interviews and focus group discussions with

relevant stakeholders to develop and validate a realist recruitment and deployment plan based on the PHC staff gap identified.

1.4.2 Data Collection Method

Preliminary data for the PHC workers' mapping and baseline was obtained from the State's Human Resources for Health Office at the State Ministry of Health and complemented with primary data collection using a structured data form presented in Annex 2 of this report. The data collected from the State's Human Resources for Health Office was as of March 2024 being the most recent data collection point. This data was triangulated using the survey data for accuracy and data credibility.

1.4.3 Methodological Limitations

Data collection was done at the LGA health authorities. This method was likely to leave out some staff whose data was not available to the LGA health authorities at the time of data collection and triangulated. The best method would have been to visit all the health facilities to collect the data, but this was not done due to time and financial constraints.

2.0 SITUATIONAL ANALYSIS

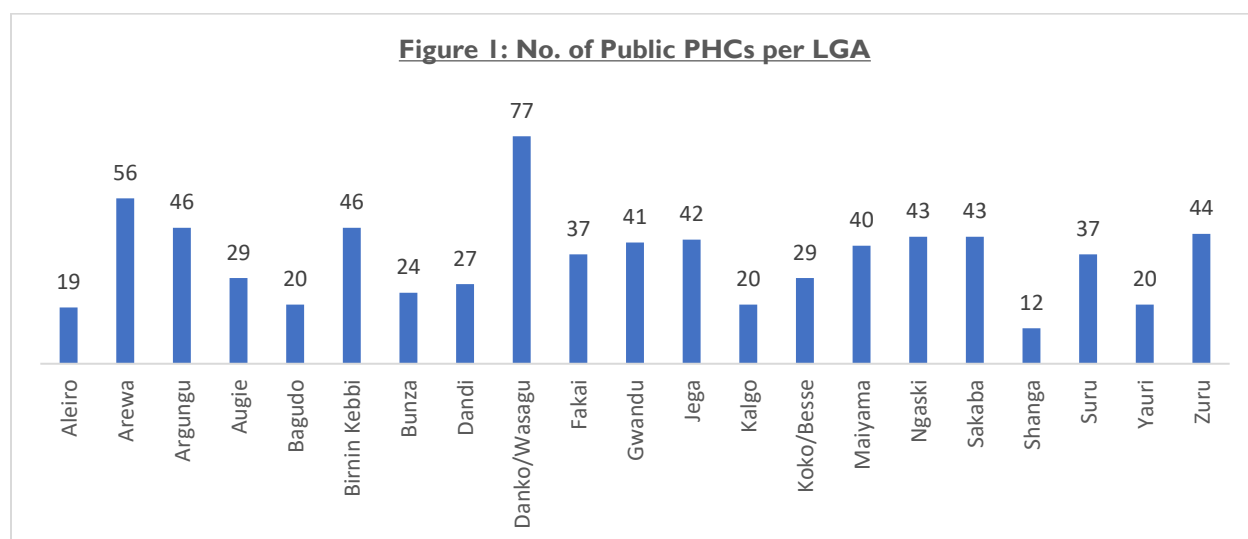
2.1 Overview of Kebbi State's Primary Healthcare System and Human Resources

The Primary Health Care System in Kebbi State, just like any other State in Nigeria and even the world, is the third level of health care whose primary role is to provide preventive services such as community mobilization, health education, personal hygiene, environmental sanitation, immunization and immediate disease outbreak notification. This level of health care also serves as the first port of call in the provision of curative health care at the health posts, dispensaries, clinics, and primary health centers. The primary health care system in the State is headed by an Executive Secretary of the Primary Health Care Development Agency (SPHCDA) who oversees the day-to-day activities and running of the primary health care system in the State. At the Local Government Level, the Directors of Primary Health Care (DPHC) are responsible for the smooth running of all primary health care activities. The DPHCs report to the Executive Secretary. At the health facility level, the Officers in-Charge, who are mostly experienced Community Health Extension Workers (CHEW), take responsibility for effective service delivery to the communities. The health facility in charge reports directly to the DPHC.

The health workforce has been one of the challenges of the Primary health care system in the State. While there is a problem of general acute shortage of health workforce to man the over 700 primary health care facilities in the State, there is also a problem of maldistribution of the workforce where health facilities in urban areas are often manned by many staff even beyond the required capacity, those in rural areas struggle with only one or two personnel. The paucity of nurses/Midwives in the workforce is also a challenge, as most of the facilities do not have any of this workforce cadre, this has been affecting maternal health service delivery at the primary health care level.

2.1.1 Number of Government-owned PHC Facilities in the State

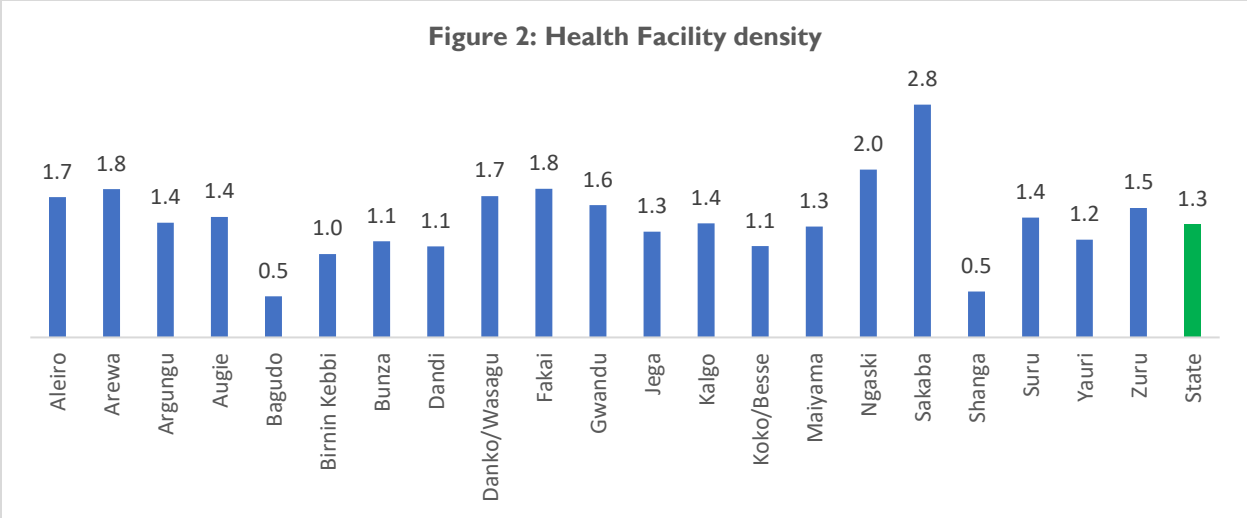
As depicted in Figure 1 below, there is a total of 752 government-owned PHCs distributed across the 21 LGAs of the State. The distribution, as depicted in Figure 1, shows that Danko-Wasagu has the highest number (77) of public PHCs while Shanga has the least (12). Out of the 752 government-owned PHCs, 225 PHC facilities receive direct facility financing (DFF) from the Basic Health Care Provision Fund (BHCPF); the details of these facilities are contained in the PHC facility database of the State.

2.1.2 PHC Facility Density in Kebbi State

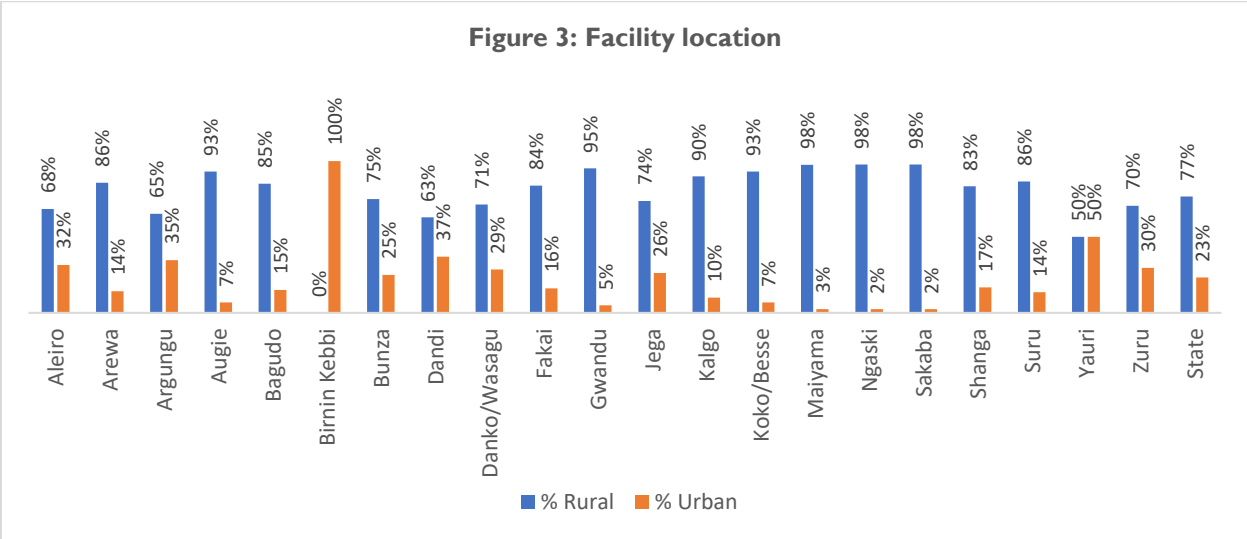
Health facility density refers to the number of health facilities (in this case public PHCs) per 10,000 population. It is an important indicator of outpatient service access. The state has a Public PHC density of 1.3 implying that for every 10,000 population in the State, one public PHC is serving the population. The LGA-specific result depicted in Figure 2 below shows that Sakaba has the highest facility density of 2.8 while Bagudo has the lowest of 0.5.

2.1.3 Location of PHC Facilities in Kebbi State and Rural-Urban Continuum

Most of the PHC facilities in the State (577, representing 77%) are in rural areas, while 175 facilities (23%) are located in urban centers. In Birnin Kebbi, all (100%) public PHC facilities are in the urban centers. In Maiyama, Sakaba, and Ngaski, most (98%) PHCs are in rural areas, as shown in Figure 3 below.

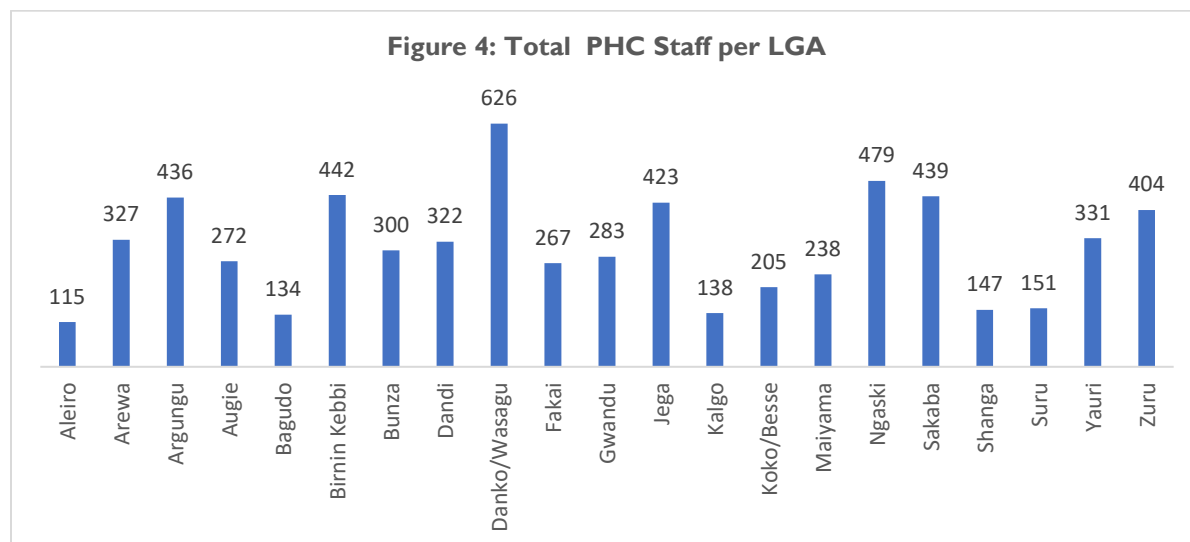

2.1.4 Current PHC Workforce in Kebbi State and their Location

2.1.4.1. Total PHC Workforce in Kebbi State by Location

The 752 PHC facilities across the State are manned by a total of 6,479 staff. In terms of absolute numbers, Danko-Wasagu has the highest number of staff (626), which is due to the high number (77) of health facilities in the LGA. Aliero, on the other hand, has the least number of staff (115) as shown in Figure 4. Although Aliero is not the LGA with the least number of facilities, it has the least number of staff which is an implication of the acute staff shortage in the LGA.

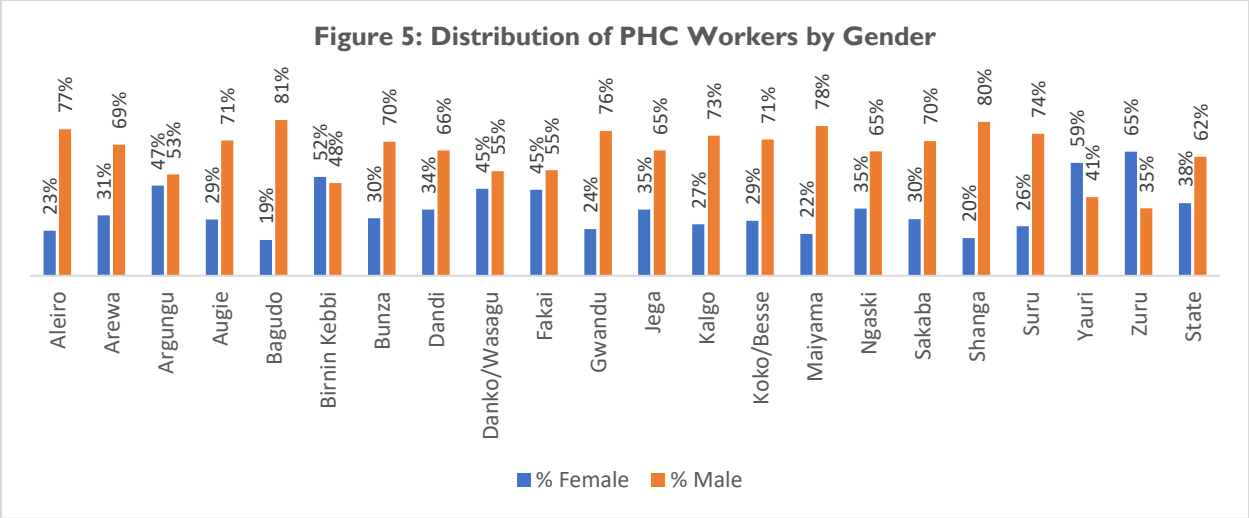

As presented in Section 2.1.1, a total of 225 PHC facilities are receiving direct facility financing from the Basic Health Care Provision Fund. The details of the workers in these facilities (already captured in the total PHC workforce analyzed above) are presented in the personnel database of all primary healthcare workers in the PHC facilities receiving direct facility financing from the Basic Health Care Provision Fund, a separate document containing the names, qualifications, experience, positions/functions, location/duty station, date of commencement of duty of the workers. This document contains private information about workers that cannot be presented publicly or published.

2.1.4.2 Distribution of PHC Workers by Gender

Distribution of the PHC workers by gender shows that 2,459 (38%) are female while 4,040 (62%) are male. Only Birnin Kebbi, Yauri, and Zuru have a higher proportion of female staff compared to males, as shown in Figure 5. In Danko-Wasagu and Argungu, the male-female workforce disparity is the least while in Shanga and Bagudo, the disparity is the highest.

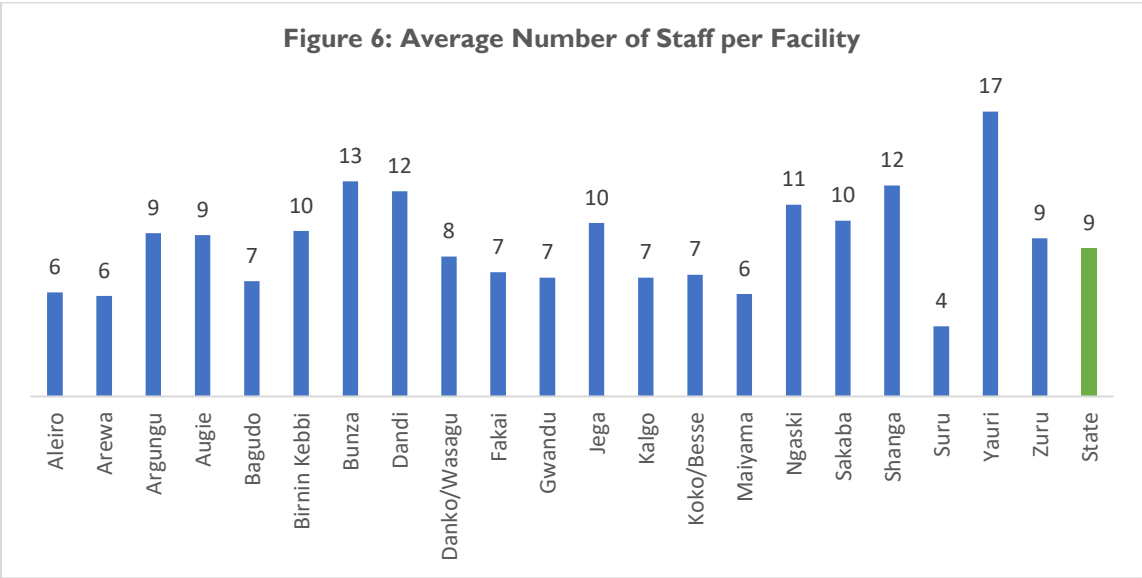

Other biographic details of PHC workers are contained in the HRH profile of Kebbi State, a document updated regularly and presents all specific details of PHC workers at the individual level, details such as names, qualifications, experience, positions/functions, duty station, and date of commencement of duty for each PHC worker.

2.1.4.3 Average PHC Worker per Facility

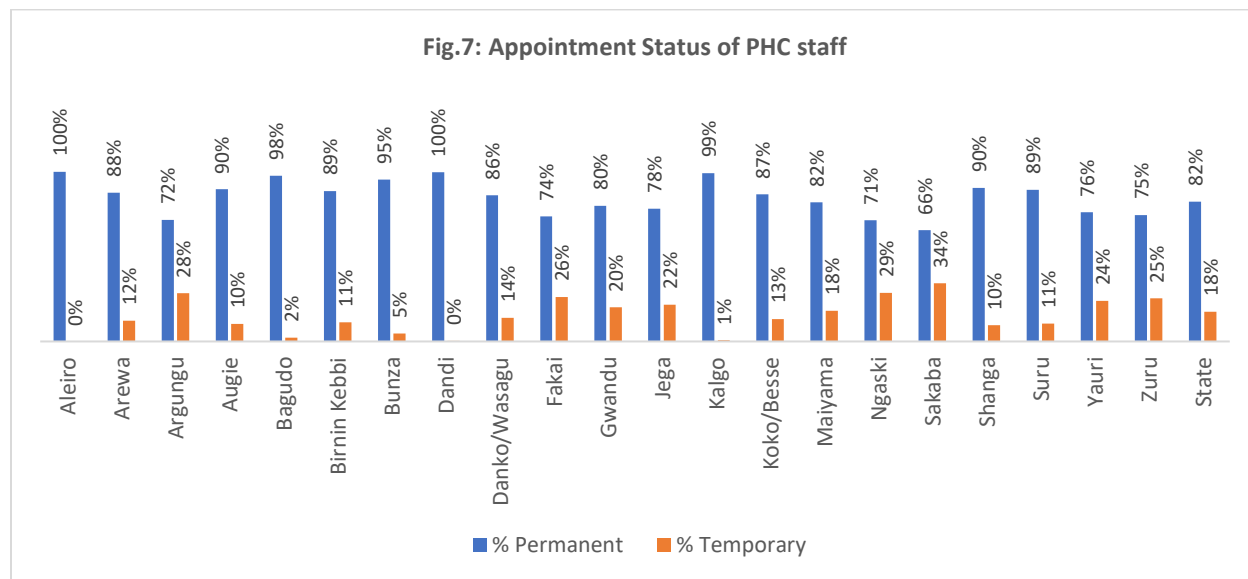
The average staff per facility across the State shows an average of 9 staff per PHC. The highest average is in Yauri LGA with 17, and the least in Suru with 4 as shown in Figure 6.

2.1.4.4 Appointment Status of PHC Staff per Local Government

Figure 7 shows that 5342 out of the 6,479 (82%) PHC staff across the State are permanent staff, while 1137 (18%) are temporary (Casual Contract, Volunteer) staff. Sakaba has the highest proportion of temporary staff (34%).

2.1.4.5 Distribution of PHC Workers by Job Area

Table 1 below shows the distribution of PHC workers in Kebbi State by job area. Out of the 6,479 workers, 3,551(55%) are core health workers, CHOs, JCHEWS, Environmental health personnel, Laboratory technicians, Pharmacy technicians, and medical record officers, while 2,928 (45%) are categorized as support staff (Health Assistants, Health Educators).

CHOs, Nurses/Midwives, and Pharmacy technicians form the smallest composition in the total workforce with 0.6%, 0.8%, and 1.1% compositions, respectively. The distribution of CHOs across the LGAs shows that 16 out of the 21 LGAs have at least one CHO, with Yauri having the highest number of 7, while 5 LGAs- Bunza, Danko-Wasagu, Koko-Besse, Sakaba, and Shanga had no CHO. 7 LGAs - Aliero, Bagudo, Bunza, Dandi, Kalgo, Maiyama, and Sakaba do not have a nurse/midwife in any of their facility, while 14 LGAs have at least one, with Birnin Kebbi having the highest number of 17 nurses/midwives. At least one Pharmacy technician is available in 17 out of 21 LGAs, with Jega having the highest number of 14.

CHEWs and environmental health personnel formed the largest proportion of the PHC health work force in the State with 20% and 16%, respectively. Jega has the highest absolute number of CHEWs (141) while Bagudo and Suru have the least (28).

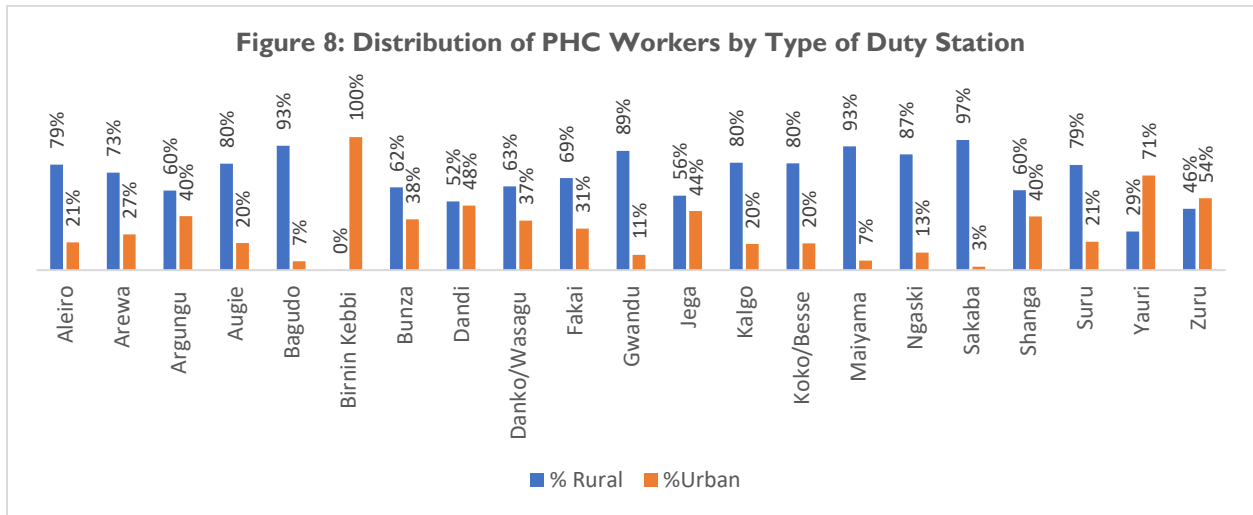

2.1.4.6 Distribution of PHC Workers by type of Duty Station (Rural-Urban Continuum)

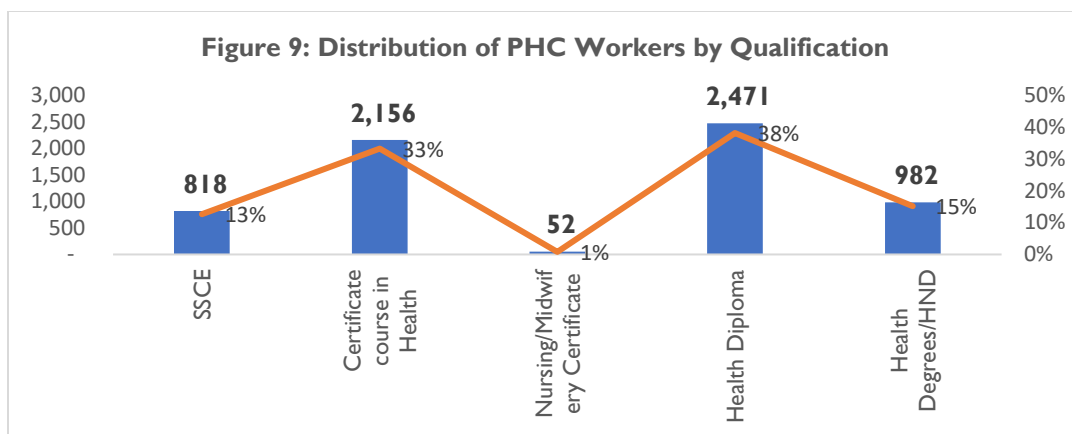
As shown in Figure 8 below, the majority of the PHC workers in the State have their duty stations in the rural areas. 4,178 (64%) of the workers are stationed in rural areas while only 2,301 (36%) have their duty stations in the urban centers. In Birnin Kebbi, all the PHC workers have their duty stations in urban areas, this is because all the PHCs are in the urban areas. Yauri and Zuru LGAs with more facilities located in the urban areas also have the majority of their PHC workers stationed in those urban facilities. Argungu, Dandi, and Jega had the least disparity of rural-urban duty stations for PHC workers, while Sakaba had the highest disparity with only 3% of the workforce stationed in the urban areas. Distribution of PHC workers by type of duty station shows a close correlation with the distribution of PHCs by location (rural-urban), as LGAs with more urban PHCs have more PHC workers stationed in urban areas and vice-versa.

2.1.4.7 Distribution of PHC Workers by Qualifications

Figure 9 below shows the distribution of PHC workers by qualification. The majority (38%) of the workforce had a health-related Diploma, while the least proportion of the workforce (1%) were those with Nurse/Midwife qualifications.

2.1.4.8 Analysis of Workers by Status of Employment

Out of the 6,479 health workers deployed across the 752 PHCs in the State, 1,137 workers are volunteers, casual/contract, and temporary staff, representing 18% of the primary health workforce. These categories of workers are volatile and may leave the service at any time without notice, given a better and permanent work opportunity. The LGA distribution of these volunteers who may leave at any time is shown in Table 2 below. Sakaba, Ngaski, and Argungu have the highest number of their workforce who may leave the service without official notice between 2025 and 2029.

2.1.4.9 Analysis of Workers Leaving the Service Between 2025 and 2029

Based on the retirement age of 60 years operational in the health sector of the State, a total of 808 out of the 5,342 full-time staff (15%) are estimated to leave the service between 2025 and 2029 through retirement. Specifically, 378 workers are estimated to leave the service by 2025, 121 by 2026, 92 by 2027, 88 by 2028, and 129 by 2029. Of this number, Bunza LGA will have the highest number of retirees during the 5 years. The other LGA breakdown of these statistics is presented in Table 3 below.

2.2 Staff Gap Analysis and Findings

2.2.1 Total PHC Staff Gap by Professional Area in Kebbi State

The 752 PHC facilities in the State are operating with a total staff gap of 11,013 given the National Primary Health Care Development Agency (NPHCDA) minimum standards for Primary health care staffing in Nigeria and the estimated number of staff projected to leave the service between 2025 and 2029. The staffing gap by professional area is shown in Table 4.

There is a 100% gap for Medical Officers in the PHCs across the State. This implies zero availability of the Officers as required. Environmental Officers on the other hand have a 0% gap implying that this professional area has an adequate number of personnel available to meet the required standard. Community Health Officers have a 94% gap while Junior Community Health Extension Workers and Pharmacy Technicians have a 90% gap each.

2.2.2 Summary of PHC Staff Gap by Location

The PHC staff gap by location (LGA duty station) is shown in Table 5 below. The workforce gap analysis showed that there is a surplus of 276 Environmental Health Officers in the State, with Danko-Wasagu having the highest surplus of 85 officers. Jega and Yauri have a surplus of 15 CHEWs each, while Arewa and Danko-Wasagu have the widest CHEW gap of 111 and 112, respectively. Only Zuru had a surplus of 11 Laboratory personnel. For Nurses/Midwives, Junior Community Health Extension workers, and Pharmacy Technicians, all the LGAs had workforce gaps.

2.2.3 Summary of PHC Staffing Gap by Facility

Appendix 3 shows the current PHC Staffing gap by facility. All the 752 facilities have a gap for a Medical Officer. 280 health facilities across the State have a gap for 3 CHEWs each, 199 have a gap for 2 CHEWs each, and 112 for 1 CHEW each. Only 51 out of the 752 health facilities across the State had no gap for CHEW. While the aforementioned facilities have varying gaps for CHEW, the health facilities listed in Table 6 below had at least 10 Surplus CHEWs. This finding could be a useful hint for staff re-distribution and equitable and efficient human resource utilization.

Nurse/Midwife gap by facility shows that only 2 out of the 752 PHCs (Birnin Kebbi Police Barracks Clinic, and Gesse Vesicle Vagina Fistula Centre all in Birnin Kebbi) had more than the required number of Nurses/Midwife. Only one PHC (Tungar Dodo Primary Health Center in Suru LGA) had no gap for a Nurse/Midwife. Therefore, 749 (97%) PHCs in the State have a gap for at least one Nurse/Midwife.

2.3 Institutional Structure for Primary Health Human Resource Management in Kebbi State.

Though the State Primary Health Care Development Agency is responsible for the administration of primary health care in the State, the primary health care facilities and their human resources are managed by the Ministry for Local Government and Chieftaincy Affairs. The Primary Health Care Under One Roof policy made several attempts to migrate PHC workers to the State Primary Health

Care Development Agency, but such attempts have been unsuccessful. Currently, there seems to be a fragmented line of authority for the PHC workers in the State with directives coming both from the State Primary Health Care Development Agency and the Ministry for Local Government and Chieftaincy Affairs.

2.3.1 Minimum Standard for PHC Workers

The minimum standard for PHC workers in the State and the maximum worker-to-patient ratio is presented in Table 7 below. The minimum standard was adopted from the National Primary Health Care Development Agency's minimum staffing standard for PHCs in Nigeria. The State has, however, not yet achieved this standard, especially for the Medical Officer and Nurse/Midwife cadre. The State is working towards achieving this minimum standard for both rural and urban health facilities in the next five (5) years. The same minimum staffing standards were retained for both rural and urban PHC facilities while the worker-to-patient ratio is slightly different between the rural area and the urban areas.

2.3.2 Gender and Social Inclusion Requirements in Kebbi State

Kebbi State government is gender sensitive and conscious of the need for social inclusiveness in its PHC policies. This is evident in the State's efforts to employ and deploy female staff to the PHCs, support female students in health-producing institutions, and the availability of gender-sensitive facilities in the PHCs.

2.4 Challenges of PHC Workers Recruitment, Deployment and Retention in Kebbi State

PHC Workers Recruitment, Deployment, and Retention in Kebbi State faces challenges as the Ministry responsible for Recruitment, Deployment, and Retention differs from the agency saddled with the responsibility of coordinating and ensuring effective and efficient day-to-day service provision at the facility level. In this case, the coordinating agency cannot hire and fire even when a dire need arises.

3.0 RECRUITMENT/DEPLOYMENT PLAN AND COSTING

3.1 Recruitment Plan

This section presents the recruitment plan of the State, taking into consideration the projected annual population growth rate of 3.98% according to the Kebbi State Industrial Policy Document¹. With the population projected to be 4,440,050 in 2016², the State's population is estimated to grow from 6,308,646 in 2025, to 6,559,730 in 2026, 6,820,808 in 2027, 7,092,276 in 2028, and 7,374,548 by 2029. This population growth and the estimated number of workers due for retirement between 2025 and 2029 will put considerable pressure on the primary health workforce in the State in the future and have been considered in this requirement plan. The annual population increase was estimated to increase the staffing gap by 3 workers annually in rural areas, and by 4 workers annually in urban areas to meet the new additions to the population. These gaps are already captured as part of the general staff gap analysis.

3.1.1 PHC Workers Recruitment Plan by Job Area (5-year Projection)

The PHC worker's recruitment plan shown in Table 8 below was drafted based on the staffing gap identified per job area, the estimated number of staff due for retirement, and the projected impact of population growth on the primary healthcare workforce. The plan shows that 750 Medical Officers would be recruited over 5 years to fill the gap of medical officers in the primary health care system of the State. Similarly, at least 296 Nurses/Midwives will be recruited yearly to fill the gaps in Nurses/Midwives. The recruitment for other job areas is presented in Table 8.

3.1.2 Workers Recruitment Plan by Classification of Duty Station

Most of the recruitment to be done will be channeled to fill the gaps at the rural duty stations as shown in Table 9 below. Notably, the future workforce requirements based on the population projection in Section 3.1 will increase the future staff gap by 3 workers in the rural area (Nurse, CHO, and CHEW) and 4 workers in the urban areas (2 Nurses, CHO, and CHEW), which have been integrated into the recruitment and deployment plan.

3.1.3 PHC Workers Recruitment by LGA

The gaps identified per job area in the LGAs provided insights on the recruitment plan by LGA as shown in Table 10 below. In Arewa and Danko-Wasagu LGAs, 111 and 112 CHEWs will be recruited to fill estimated gaps. Danko-Wasagu will not need to recruit any environmental officer

since there is an excess of 85 in the LGA, re-distribution among the facilities is what will be needed to ensure each facility has an adequate number of personnel.

3.1.4 PHC Workers Recruitment by Duty Station (PHC Facility)

PHC worker recruitment by facility will be done using the staff gap by facility as shown in Appendix 3. A total of 752 Medical Officers will be recruited for all the 752 PHC facilities. 3 CHEWs will be recruited for each of the 280 health facilities across the State that have a gap for 3 CHEWs, and 2 CHEWs will be recruited for each of the 199 PHCs that have a gap for 2 CHEWs each. There will be staff redistribution for facilities that have excess numbers.

3.1.5 Recruitment Strategy

The State plans to employ the following strategies to fill the existing worker gap in the PHCs. These strategies include:

- i. Staff re-distribution. This will involve transferring staff from duty stations where they are surplus to duty stations with a shortage of such personnel. For example, in Table 6, the Surplus CHEWs can be re-distributed to other health facilities within the LGA.
- ii. Conversion of the 1,137 volunteers into permanent staff for all that are willing and qualified.
- iii. Opening the vacancy to existing qualified health workers in secondary healthcare facilities in the State for voluntary conversion.
- iv. Recruitment of the outstanding gap through recruitment calls from externally qualified candidates after implementing the above strategies.

3.2 Deployment plan

3.2.1 PHC Workers Deployment Plan by Classification of Duty Station

The PHC Workers Deployment Plan by Classification of Duty Station presented in Table 11 below shows that more of the recruited staff will be deployed to the rural areas since a substantial proportion of the PHCs are located there. For example, 577 Medical Officers to be recruited will be deployed to the rural areas while only 175 will be deployed to the urban areas. The deployment for other skill areas is presented in Table 11.

3.2.2 Framework for Equitable Workers Deployment

To ensure equitable worker deployment, the State government will ensure priority is given to the rural areas with a minimum of 70% of annual recruitment deployed to the rural areas. To ensure the workers stay and serve at the duty stations they are deployed to (particularly the rural areas), all health facilities will be provided a decent work environment and working conditions/accommodation along with rural posting allowance/incentives. The government will also encourage indigenes to study health courses to serve their communities upon graduation.

3.3 Multi-Year Costed PHC Workers Recruitment and Deployment Plan

As depicted in Table 12 below, the state will require about ₦1.35 billion in 2025, ₦1.12 billion in 2026, ₦898.8 million in 2027, ₦695.86 million in 2028, and ₦463.90 million in 2029 to recruit the required primary healthcare workers from 2025 to 2029, train and deploy them, pay them minimum wage and allowances, and provide necessary supplies and work tools/equipment to enable them to do their jobs effectively. The estimated impact of the inflationary trend has been factored into these costs.

4.0 RECOMMENDATIONS

Based on the findings of the baseline exercise, the following recommendations were made.

- i. Surplus PHC workers in facilities with surpluses should be redistributed to the facilities with shortages.
- ii. Kebbi State government should increase budgetary allocation to the primary health sector to address the massive human resource gap identified in the system.
- iii. Kebbi State government should centralize the management of primary health care activities to the primary health care development agency in line with the principle of Primary Health Care Under One Roof (PHCUOR).

5.0 CONCLUSION

The baseline mapping exercise for primary healthcare workers in Kebbi State has revealed significant gaps in the human resources required to deliver quality healthcare services across the state. The findings underscore the urgent need for strategic interventions to address the shortages of healthcare workers, particularly in rural areas where the majority of the population resides. The data presented in this report provides a clear picture of the current state of the primary healthcare workforce and serves as a foundation for future planning and decision-making.

To ensure the effective delivery of primary healthcare services, the Kebbi State Government must take immediate steps to address the identified gaps. This includes increasing budgetary allocations to the health sector, centralizing the management of primary healthcare activities under the Kebbi State Primary Healthcare Development Agency, and implementing a robust recruitment and deployment plan. Additionally, efforts must be made to improve the working conditions and incentives for healthcare workers, particularly those serving in rural areas, to enhance retention and motivation.

The recommendations outlined in this report provide a roadmap for strengthening the primary healthcare system in Kebbi State. By addressing the human resource gaps and improving the overall management of the healthcare workforce, we can ensure that every resident of Kebbi State has access to the quality healthcare services they deserve. The success of these efforts will depend on the continued collaboration and commitment of all stakeholders, including the government, healthcare workers, and the communities they serve. Together, we can build a healthier future for Kebbi State.
